Jason's Graduation Story

I am thankful to my parents for taking me to church as a child and offering me a good home. When I was in Jr. High School I started experimenting with marijuana and this is where the spiral of my life started. In High School I started doing cocaine and had a DUI when 19. In my mid twenties I served a 2 1/2 month prison time for robbery. I had a back injury at work in 2010. The doctor prescribed pain medication and soon I was addicted to the medication, this led to heroin addiction and soon an almost deadly overdose.

Our hope is that one last time in 2012, you would allow your heart to be stirred by the spirit of Christmas giving, passing along a much needed donation to Transition to Community/Potters House. The ongoing work of ministering to the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of men coming into our community is a rewarding ministry, but also exhausts our resources.
